CEMETERY REPORT: Max said got the new roads in cemetery, looks good. working on plots now, going to get some prices and talk to Parrish Excavating.

OLD BUSINESS:

A: PROSPECT POINT ASSESSMENT: taken care of during public hearings.

B: PERPETUAL CARE BIDS: Have one bid, Neitzet's Greenhouse, 2 year bid. spring 2021 and spring 2022, a spike, 2 vinca vines, 2 flowering annuals and 2 zonal (cutting) geraniums, with time release fertilizer in soil. 421 urns plus 5 cast iron urns \$10,000.00, each additional urn \$24.75 each. NEW BUSINESS:

A: GOLF CART TRAIL: Ray said trail is being misused by 4 wheelers. Lots of trash being left behind.
